## Scholarship opportunity to cover living expenses in Semester 2, 2022

### AUT Accommodation Scholarship – Disability, Deaf or Rainbow 2022

This new AUT scholarship provides support with accommodation for students who:

- Identify with a disability; or
- Are Deaf; or
- Are from the rainbow community

It's an opportunity for students to find a home away from home by living in our student accommodation facilities at the City Campus. Students will get the chance to explore living independently close to the City Campus, without the barriers of travel and cost of accommodation.

### ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

#### The scholarship covers

- Fully paid rental in a studio-style apartment for Semester 2, 2022 for a single resident

#### The scholarship does not cover

- Accommodation application fee
- Student residential life fee

#### Scholarship duration

- For Semester 2, 2022 only

#### AUT's Te Āhuru Mayoral Drive student accommodation facility

- Located minutes away from AUT's City Campus
- 24-hour safety and security
- 24-hour onsite staff (accommodation staff, duty manager, and live-in residential assistants)
- Residential Life programme to get to know other people and get involved in social events
- If you require in-home support and care related to a disability, we can work with you and your care provider to allow this to continue

### HOW TO APPLY

1

Fill the application form before midnight on 17 June 2022



APPLICATION FORM

Application form should include:

1. Proof of your offer of place or enrolment for 2022
2. Personal statement (maximum 500 words) outlining your academic goals, career aspirations and connections or contributions to disability or rainbow networks. You must also elaborate on how the scholarship will assist you with completing your studies.

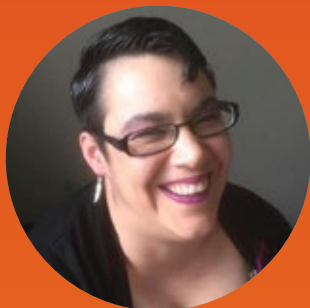
